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When I was growing up, there was a very nice unmarried school teacher who lived right across the street from my grandparents. She had a horse named Pete which she kept in a small stable very near the road. All of the children in the neighborhood would stop by and peek in at Pete and if, by some lucky chance, the door was open and he was looking out, we would step up on the large rock that had conveniently been placed right beside the door and pat his nose. I remember how soft and velvety it felt. Pete and his owner are now long since gone, but to this day, every time I pass by that house, I still look for the old stable and think of that gentle horse.

Size: approximately 8 " $\times 81 / 4$ ".

Materials: One skein of worsted weight cotton in a solid color (approximately 88 yards). The cloth pictured was done in Peaches \& Crème in Army Tan.

Needles: U.S. Size 6/4.0mm or 5/3.75mm Because this is a "picture" cloth, you want your fabric to be fairly dense so the design will pop out. If you are a loose knitter, then you might want to drop down a needle size.

Gauge: 4.5 sts. per inch, not critical.
